University Grants Commission in its notification UGC Regulation (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) (4th Amendment), 2016 has given a broad structure to be followed for short listing/ appointment of candidates (available at www.psou.ac.in) to the post of Associate Professor/ Professor under the University System in Appendix III Table II (B) as under:
